# **ISPO GLOBAL Educators Meeting (GEM)**

- The International Society for Prosthetics and Orthotics (ISPO) Education Committee is holding the first ever ISPO Global Educators Meeting between 25-27 June 2014 in Kobe (Japan).
- This three-day conference will host orthotic and prosthetic educators and stakeholders from across the globe, with content inspired from survey responses from the P&O educators.







# **ISPO GLOBAL Educators Meeting (GEM)**

 The goal of the meeting is to strengthen and deepen the P&O professions globally, through improved P&O education, with increased cooperation between P&O schools.







# Meeting objectives

- The meeting objectives include the following:
- 1. Strategic planning aimed at meeting the future needs of the P&O profession;
- 2. Present and discuss current education models and theories, which could improve student learning;
- 3. Encourage resource/information sharing between P&O schools, including web-based resources and future collaboration between P&O educators;
- 4. Identify the role and importance of research in the P&O practice and P&O education;
- Encourage the inclusion of user opinion in P&O program development;
- 6. Promote gender equity in P&O services and education.
